ORGANIZER

The organizer of the GOCC Run is the GOCC Staff in Luxembourg with registration number 5524

PURPOSE

- 1. promotion of the action "Post-pandemic lungs. We play for kids and adults alike".
- 2. to raise awareness of medical care for all people.
- 3. promotion of a healthy and active lifestyle.
- 4. the collection of fees will be donated in its entirety to the Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity

DATE and VENUE

- 1. The run will take place on 28 January 2024 in Senningerberg, Niederanven.
- 2. The run will start at 10.00 a.m.
- 3. the start and finish line will be located in Trailhead Parking, 2443 Senningerberg, Niederanven.

- 4. The route will be laid out on a 5 km loop. Most of the route runs in the forest, some part on a cycling path (asphalt)
- 5. Length of the route: 10 km and 5 km

The route will be marked and protected by volunteers.

PARTICIPATION RULES

- 1. Competitors who are at least 10 years old can take part in the GOCC Run. Underage participants must have a written consent of a parent or legal guardian
- 2. Every participant taking part in the GOCC Run must be registered at the Race Office.
- 3. Competitors take part in the competition at their own risk, acceptance of the rules is equivalent to a statement of health allowing the participation in the competition.
- 4. All participants of the GOCC Run are obliged to follow the instructions of persons responsible for safety, government services and the Organization's service.

By accepting these Rules and Regulations the participant agrees to his/her image being published, shown and used in accordance with the provisions of the Rules and Regulations of the Run.

APPLICATIONS AND REGISTER FEE

- 2. The following are all considered as entries
- The limit for the number of participants in the race will be set at the start of the race.
- 3. The limit for the GOCC Run is 100 participants. The organiser reserves the right to close the registration early if the entry list is full.
- 4. The starting fee for the participation in the GOCC Competition is EUR 25 for the distance of 10 km:

EUR 25 for the distance of 10 km

EUR 10 for the distance of 5 km

EUR 30 for participation in the Family Walk.

The register fee will be donated to the 32nd Final of the Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity.

- 5. The organisers will not issue VAT invoices.
- 6. The proof of successful registration will be sent by email with a confirmation of registration.
- 7. The fee once paid is not refundable. It is not possible to transfer the fee paid to another participant.
- 8. Each participant will receive as part of the participation fee
- a. starting number with four safety pins,
- b. refreshments at the finish line and a cold revitalizing snack,
- c. unique participation medal

- 3. The organizer does not provide medical care on the route and at the finish line.
- 4. The organizer will not be liable for any damage caused during the event.
- 5. The race will take place no matter of weather conditions.
- 6. the participants take part in the race at their own risk and it is recommended that they take out insurance at their own expense against accidents that may occur during the race.
- 7. Participants must be insured against accidents at their own expense.
